Dear Parents/Guardians and Community Members,

The Governing Board of the Hamilton Unified School District is seeking volunteer applicants (non-paid) to serve on the Citizens Oversight Committee for the recently approved General Obligation Bond.

The committee has a specific structure that is established by law, those requirements are as follows:

1. A member representing PTA/PTO/Boosters or School Site Council.
2. A parent from the District.
3. A member of a business organization representing the business community located within the District.
4. A member of a senior citizens organization.
5. A member of the taxpayers' organization (this includes groups of landowners, e.g. homeowners' associations).
6. Up to two members at large.

Please note that the members of the committee, may not be employees of the District, vendors, contractors or consultants to the District as that would be a conflict. This also extends to part-time employees, including substitute teachers. Any individual who provides a service to the District, even sporadically, are also precluded.

To apply, please send a short letter of interest to the Governing Board of the Hamilton Unified School District expressing your interest and which one of the six categories you wish to be considered.
